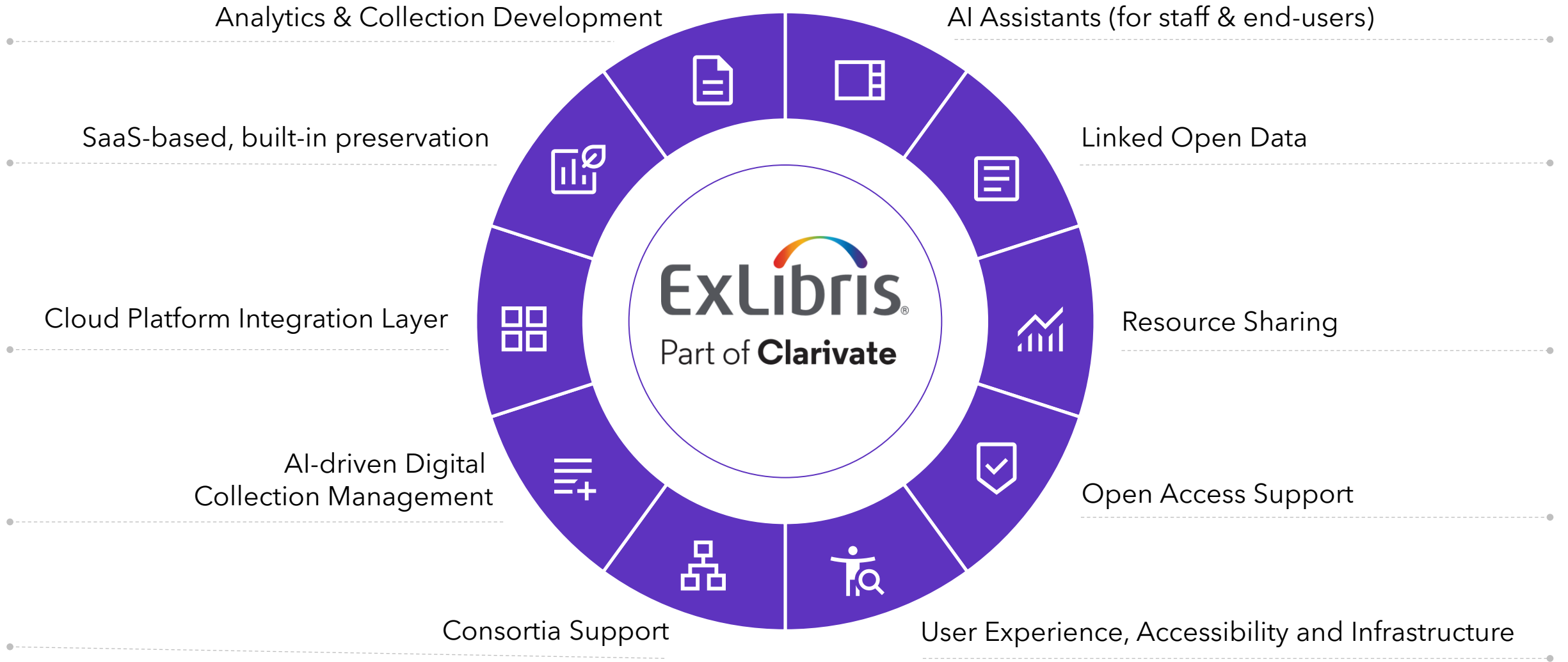

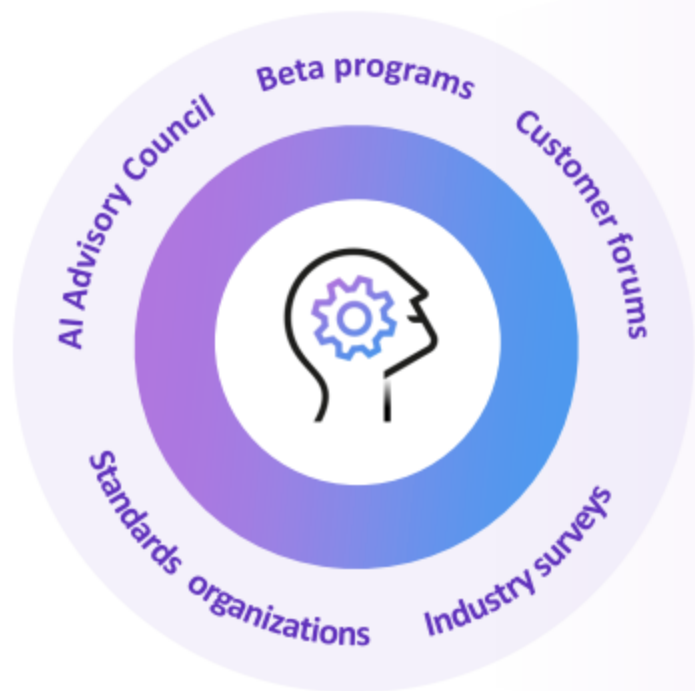

### Transparent

- Clear information about the content sources used
- Proper attribution and easy access to cited works



### Ethical

- Measures to reduce bad information
- Collaboration with publishers to ensure clear usage rights
- Collaboration with industry org. for responsible AI implementations



### Safe

- Human-in-the-loop
- Uphold privacy & security standards
- Adherence to evolving global regulations

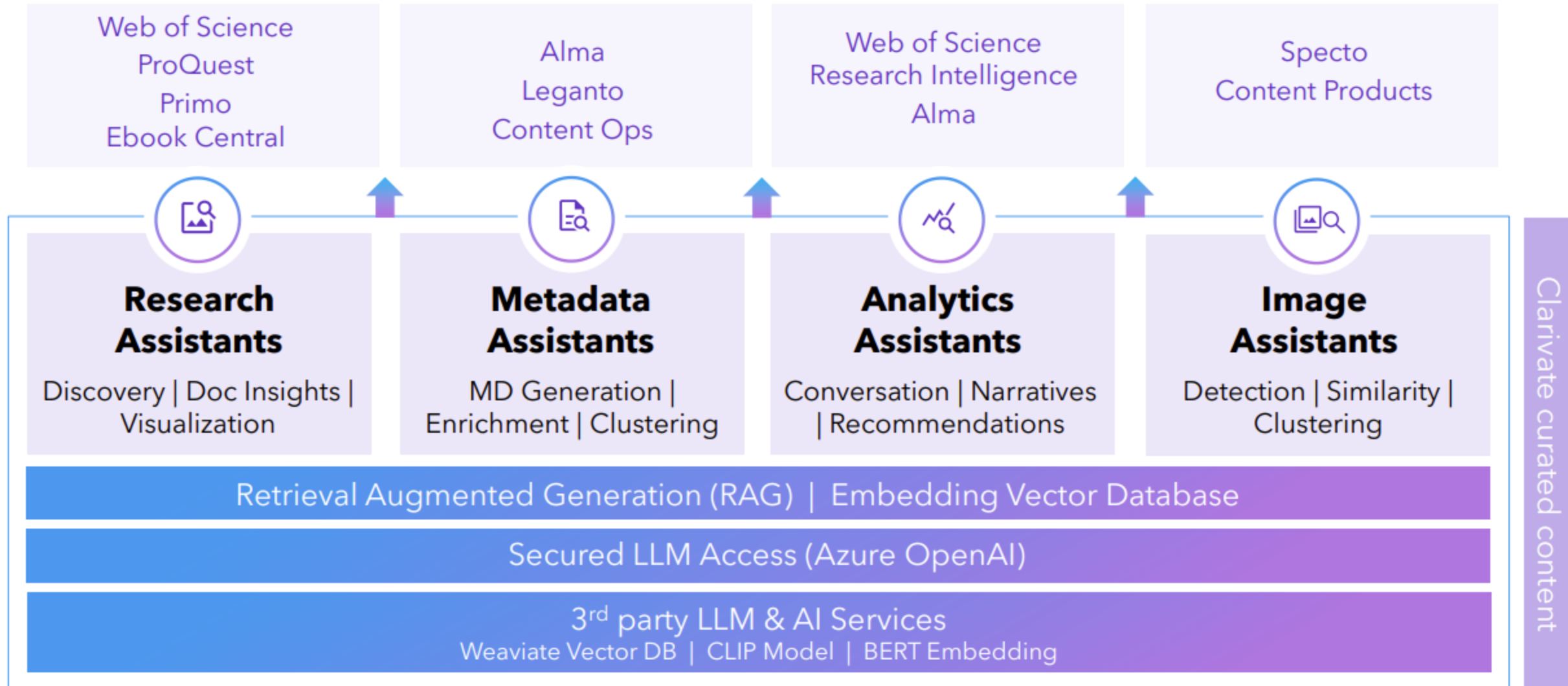

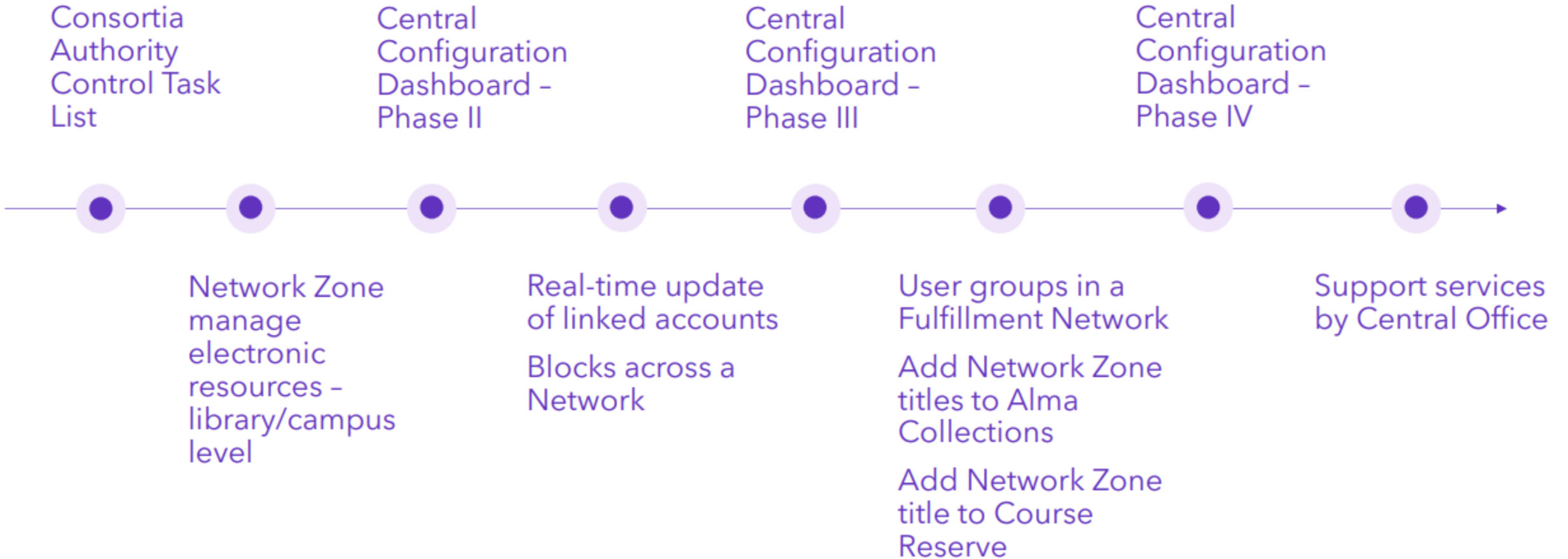

# AI Metadata Assistant

Who are we helping and why?



## Cataloging is hard, expensive work

It's difficult, time-consuming, and requires specialists that are familiar with cataloging standards to maintain the library's metadata quality.



## Library catalogs are often varied

Catalogers often find themselves working on resources in fields they're not familiar with.



## The amount of resources is growing uncontrollable

It's become impossible for libraries to keep up, even if they add more budgets and personnel

# AI Metadata Assistant: Phase I

- Two new workflows in the Metadata Editor
  - Create new record
  - Enrich existing record
- Phase I scope: Support for MARC 21 English books with LCSH vocabulary
- What we're doing:
  - Utilizing LLM text and vision APIs to assist catalogers in metadata creation
  - Keeping control with the library and librarians
  - Validating and filtering results for better quality (e.g. existing subject headings)
  - No training of the AI (the provided data is used, but not kept)

# AI Metadata Assistant Status

## Early Access in progress

- Improve workflows

Alexandre Dumas (UK: , US: ; French: [ɑlɛksɑ̃dʁ dymɑ]; born Dumas Davy de la Pailleterie [[dymo davi de la pajɛt(ə)si]], 24 July 1802 – 5 December 1870), also known as Alexandre Dumas père, was a French novelist and playwright. His works have been translated into many languages and he is one of the most widely read French authors. Many of his historical novels of adventure were originally published as serials, including *The Count of Monte Cristo*, *The Three Musketeers*, *Twenty Years After* and *The Vicomte of Bragelonne: Ten Years Later*. Since the early 20th century, his novels have been adapted into nearly 200 films. Prolific in several genres, Dumas began his career by writing plays, which were successfully produced from the first. # Current Situation Collection Development



## Operational Analytics

- All libraries use Analytics provided in Platform
  - Dashboards and Widgets
  - Scheduled
  - Ad hoc
- Over 17 million reports run in 2023
- YOY increase of 28%



## Collection Development

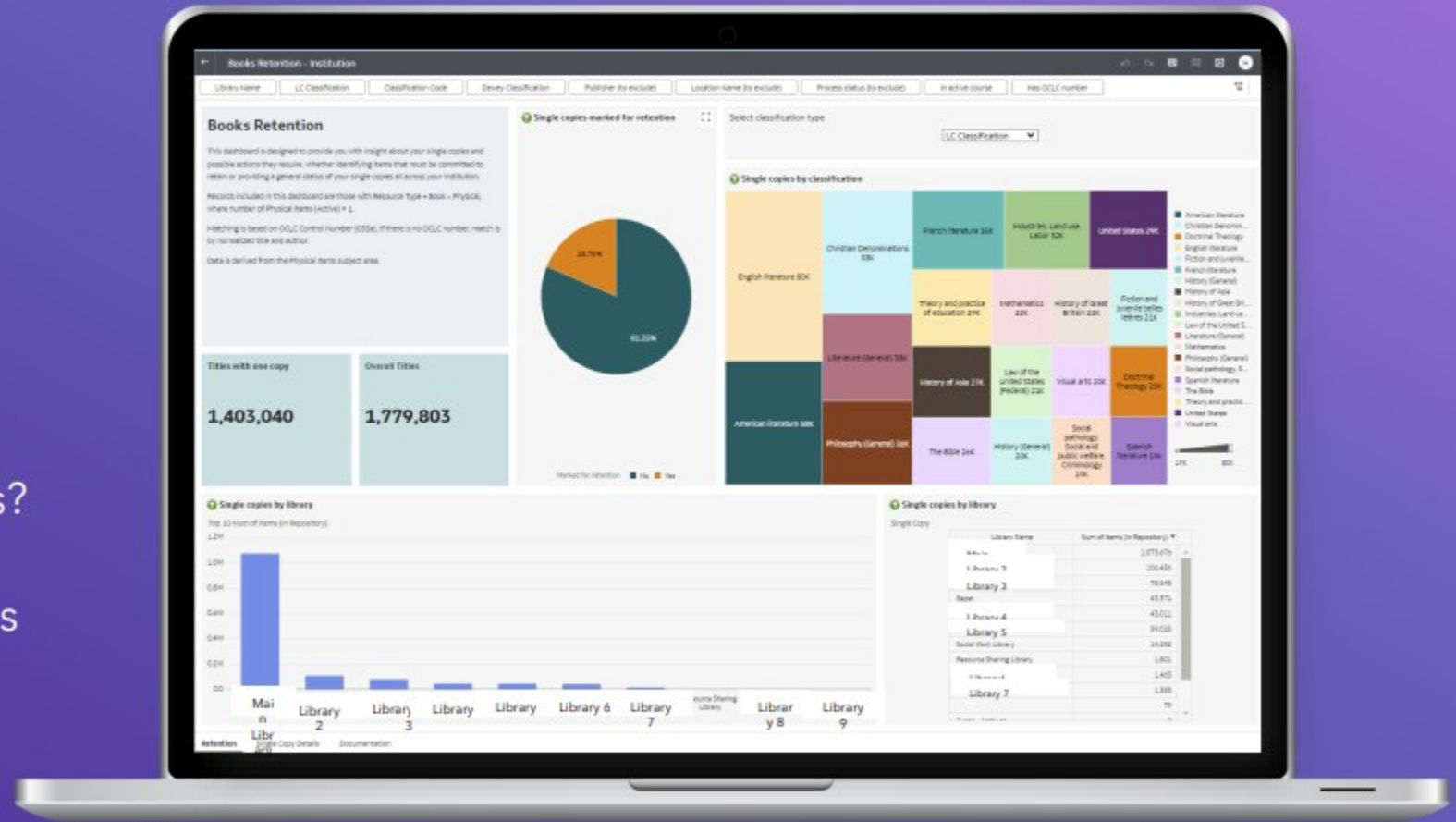
- Launched a Focus Group last year with 33 Members
